If church leadership at this time determines its advisability.

-Wednesday Prayer Mtg. re-start- July 8<sup>th</sup> -Men and women's ministries resume monthly gatherings.

-No VBS this summer

## **Considerations for Sunday Worship Services**

-IMPORTANT! If anyone has a fever, is displaying symptoms of a virus or suspects they might be sick-it is best to stay at home. Equally important, if anyone feels that their health might be comprised by attending, it is best to stay at home. <u>WE LOVE YOU EITHER WAY!</u>

-Hand sanitizing stations at entrance in foyer -Masks optional (use good judgement, do what <u>you</u> feel <u>you</u> should do, don't force your decision on others.)

-Seating according to 6" social distancing (every other row will be taped off)

-No "Love offering fellowship time" at this time

-No more than three people in the bathrooms at a time.

-Greeters open doors for attenders

# -Greeters dismiss attender's one row at a time at the close of service.

-Do not mingle in the aisles, make your way outside, and observe social distancing (6ft)

## **One Additional Thought:**

This will not go on forever! As the old saying goes "This too shall pass." We are trying to do our part to keep our congregation healthy. For some of our people, this will be too early and for others, it's not early enough. We understand that. Like every ministry, organization or individual we don't have all the facts.
